Johannes Milan's ceramics exude life. There is a relaxedness in the organic shape of this bowl. Visible hand-pressed marks on the interior create a dappled texture and softness that is accentuated by the clear nepheline glaze. [1] Simple cobalt markings animate the interior and are a language used by Milan across his tableware (see also 50763 and 50796).
Milan apprenticed for five years in France with Jean-Nicolas Gerard (see 50741) making slip earthenware before setting up his own studio in Germany, where he now lives and works.
